In its 17th year, the annual benefit dinner and contemporary art auction held on Saturday broke records in terms of funds raised and number of stylish attendees. A perfect storm of honoree (92-year-old art icon Ellsworth Kelly), venue (Cindy and Howard Rachofsky's Richard Meier-designed home brimming with contemporary masterpieces), hometown hosts (Art world power couple The Rachofskys along with this year's chair, philanthropist Nancy Rogers), artists (past honoree Richard Phillips, Elizabeth Taylor's grandson Quinn Tivey, and auction highlight Wyatt Kahn), world-famous street style star and Dallas resident Nasiba Adilova (who filled tables with fashion friends Peter Pilotto, Prabal Gurung, Sabine Getty, Emilia Wickstead, Adam Lippes, and Vika Gazinskaya), and entertainment (Robin Thicke took the stage and socials China Chow and Rosetta Getty hit the dance floor).

The evening's elements in turn raised a record \$8.3 million to benefit amfAR and the Dallas Museum of Art, with Ellsworth Kelly's White Form fetching \$2.3 Million. To date, over 190 works of art have been acquired by the Dallas Museum of Art with proceeds from TWO x TWO.
